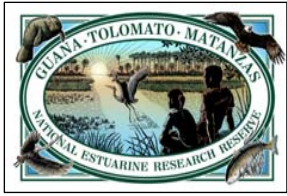

Facilities & Recreational Area

Environmental Education Center (EEC) (includes indoor exhibits, outdoor amphitheatre):

Open to the public: 7 days a week but closed state holidays

Business hours: 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

Entrance Fees: Adult (over 17) \$2.00, Child (age 10 - 17) \$1.00, Under age 10 Free (Groups of 10 or more require reservations)

Annual GTMNERR Passes may be used to gain admittance into EEC (One annual GTMNERR pass card per immediate family.)

*Some education programs may require an additional fee.

Recreational Area (includes Guana River dam area, trails, boat ramps and parking lots):

***** (Groups of 20 or more require special use permit—call the EEC for application) *****

***** Beach Weddings, Commercial Photography, Commercial Filming require special use permit—call the EEC for application *****

Open to the public: The Guana River Road automated pay station is operational.

Business hours: Beach and hiking trails open daily 8am – sunset.

Guana Dam Recreational Area open daily 4 am – 11 pm.

Entrance Fees: **\$3.00 per vehicle or motorcycle, \$1.00 per bicyclist or pedestrian**

GTMNERR discount Annual Pass: \$53.00 includes tax

As a courtesy for regular users, the reserve is offering a discount Annual Pass for \$50 plus tax that covers vehicle, trailer, and entrance to the GTM Environmental Education Center. When used at the dam & beach lots the annual sticker must be displayed on vehicle. Please contact the Reserve at
