



GTM Research Reserve Annual Parking Pass



The GTM Annual Parking Pass is available for purchase at the GTM Visitor Center, located at 505 Guana River Rd, Ponte Vedra Beach, FL 32082 for \$53 (tax included). The pass includes access to all GTM recreational areas, including the Guana River Dam, trailhead, Visitor Center and the three beach access parking lots. It is accepted only on the GTM Research Reserve property and is not valid at state and national parks. The Annual Parking Pass admits one vehicle with up to eight passengers and expires one year after date of purchase. **Upon receipt, adhere the Parking Pass to the lower inside of the windshield on the driver's side. Lost passes will not be replaced.**

Hours

The GTM Research Reserve Visitor Center is open Tuesday – Saturday from 9 am – 4 pm and is closed on state holidays.

Beach Access Parking Lots and Hiking Trails are open daily from 8 am to sunset.

Guana River Dam is open daily from 4 am – 11 pm. No overnight use is permitted.

Rules and General Information

- Pets must be on a six-foot handheld leash, be picked up after, and be well behaved.
- Alcohol is not permitted in any area of the GTM Research Reserve.
- No hunting is allowed on the GTM Research Reserve.
- Vehicles are only allowed to pass through to the Wildlife Management Area (WMA) on designated hunting weekends, which are indicated on the FWC Guana River WMA Hunt Map.
- Permitted hunters must pass through to WMA with firearms unloaded and stored away inside their vehicles.
- Please do not litter. Remember, cigarettes butts are litter and may cause wildfires.
- Stay on the trails – use binoculars, spotting scopes and zoom lenses to view wildlife. Please do not feed, follow or approach wildlife.
- Please remember that state law protects all plants, animals, and cultural resources on the GTM Research Reserve.
- Respect other visitors and protect the quality of their experience. Move slowly and quietly so as not to disturb wildlife. Yield to other users on the trails.
